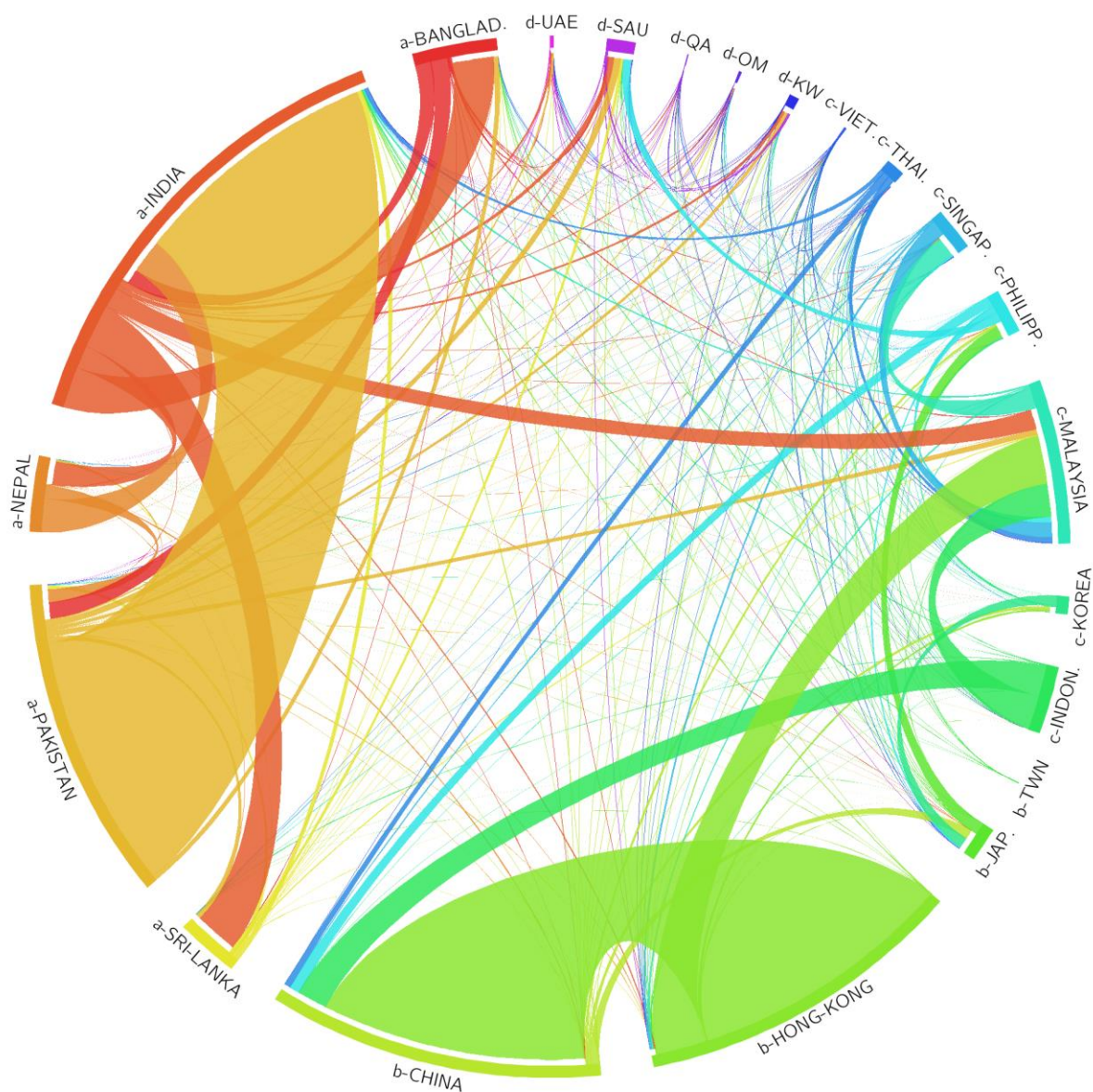
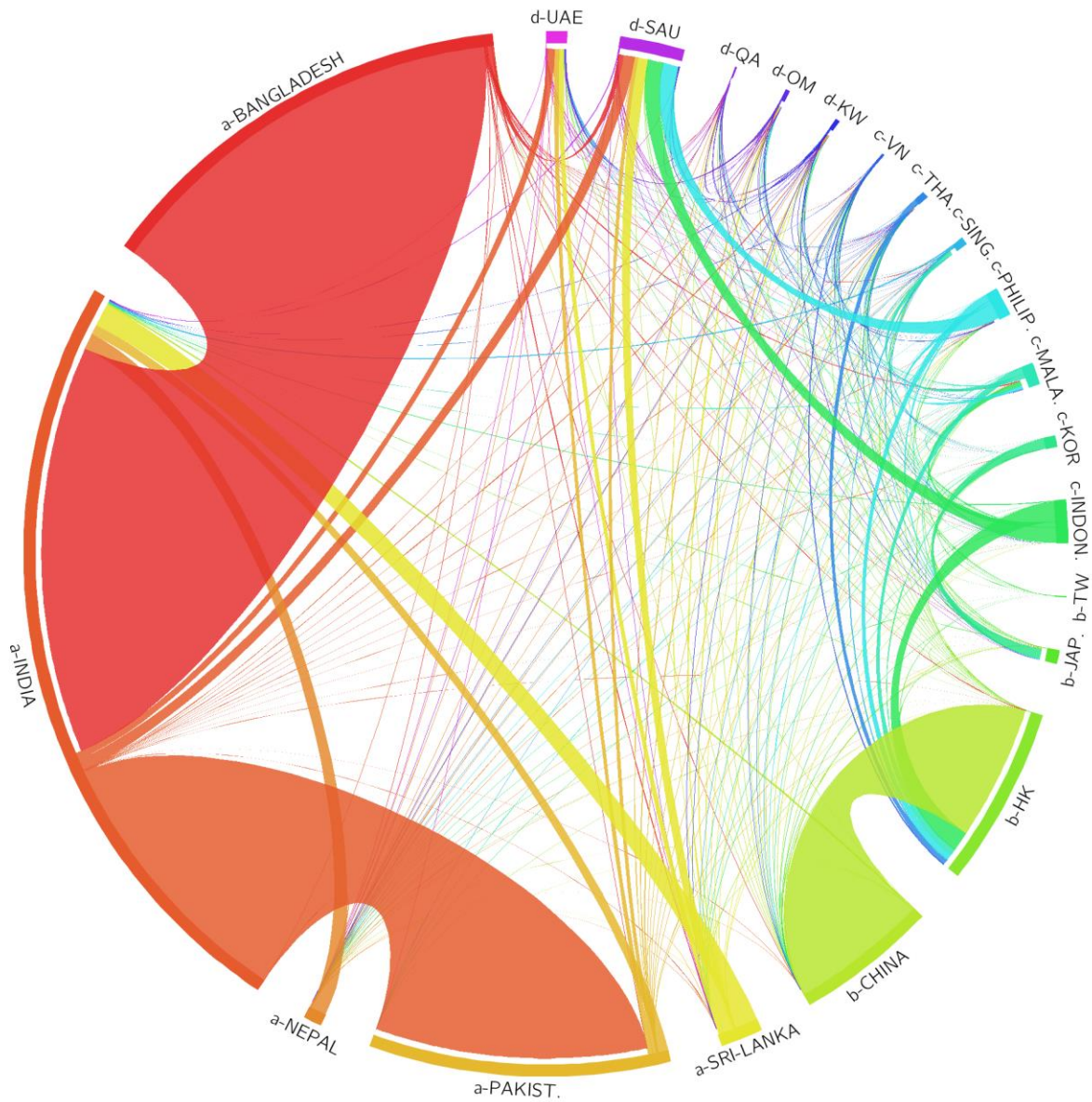


Figure One: Circular Plot of Migration Flows between Key Asian Countries, 1960 to 1970.



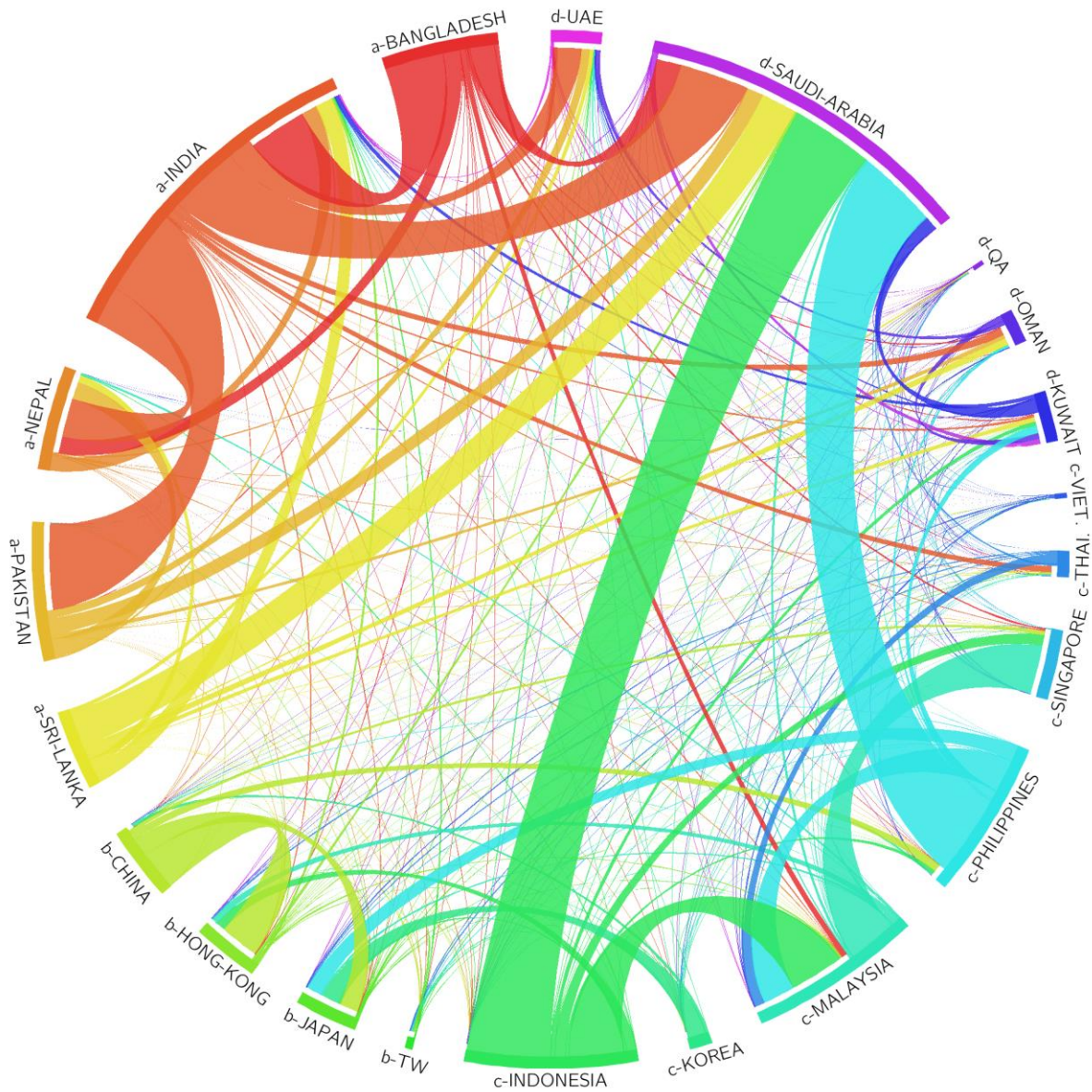

Figure Two: Circular Plot of Migration Flows between Key Asian Countries, 1970 to 1980



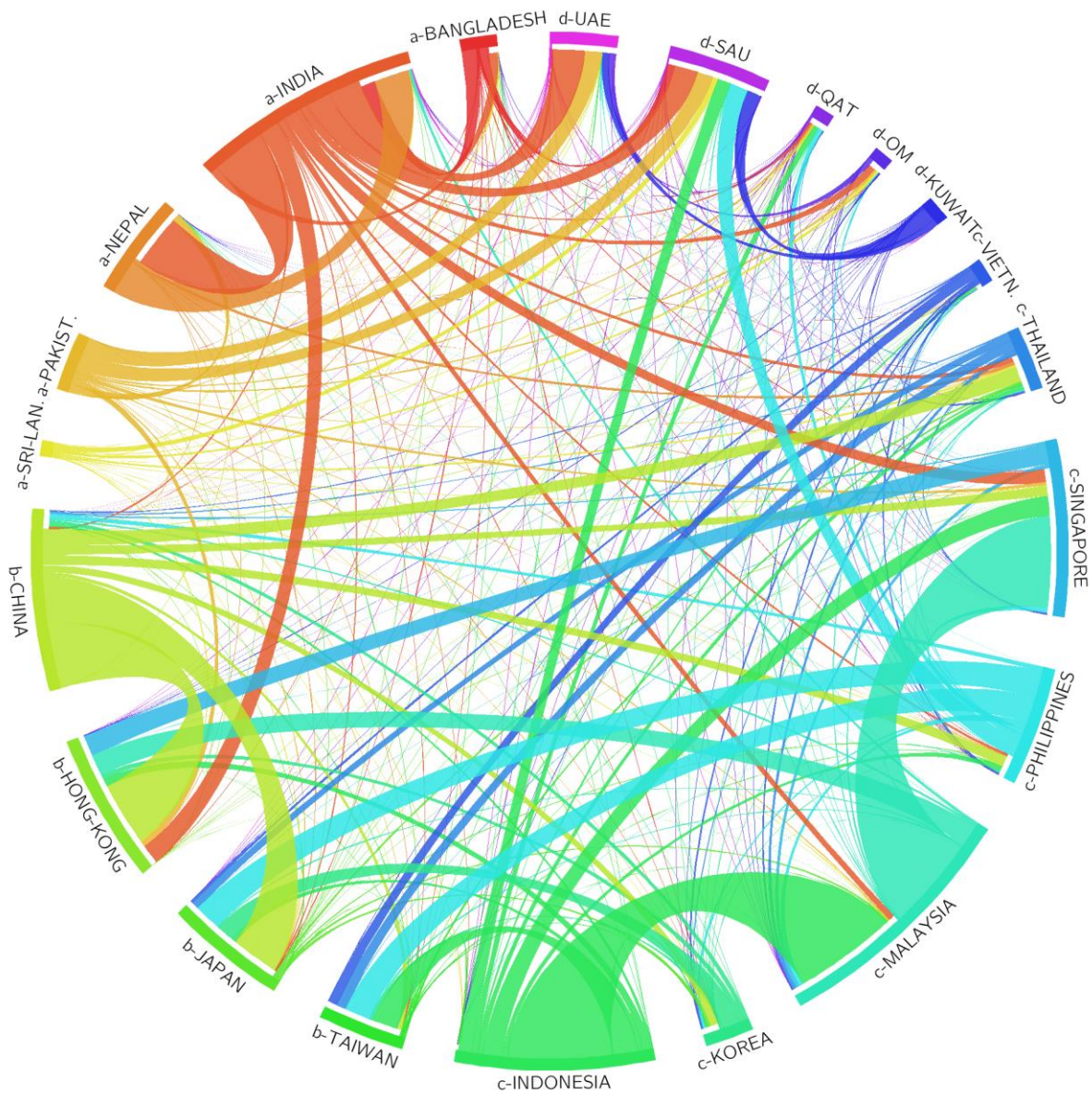

Figure Three: Circular Plot of Migration Flows between Key Asian Countries, 1980 to 1990.



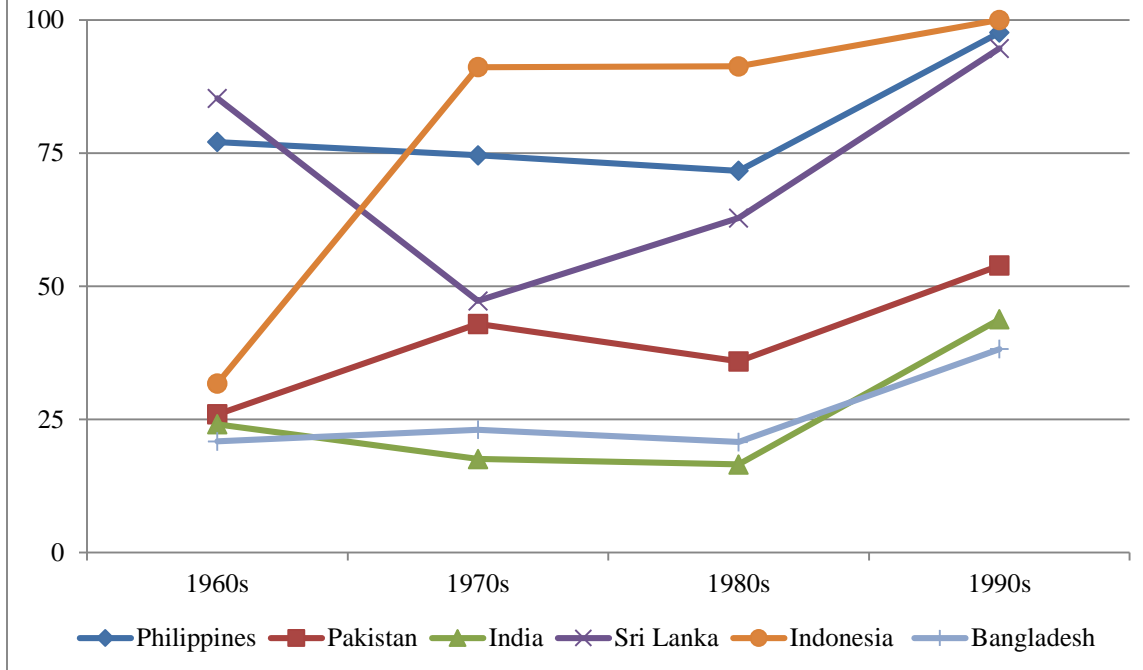

Figure Four: Circular Plot of Migration Flows between Key Asian Countries, 1990 to 2000.



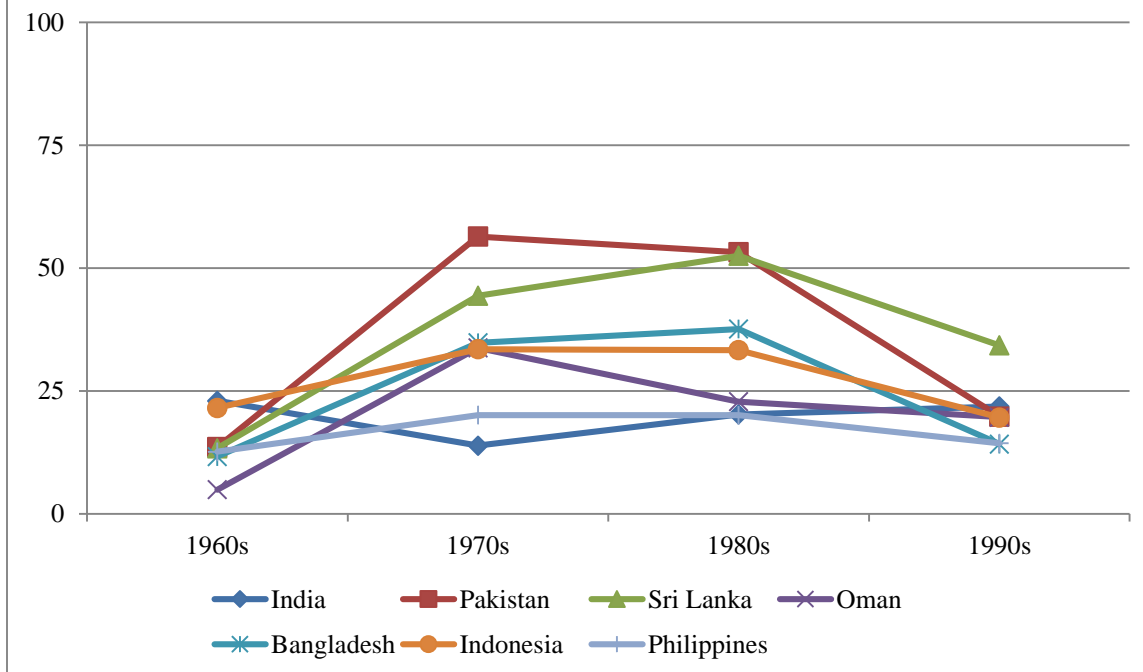

Figure Five: Percent Women Migrants to Saudi Arabia from Major Sending Countries, 1960-2000



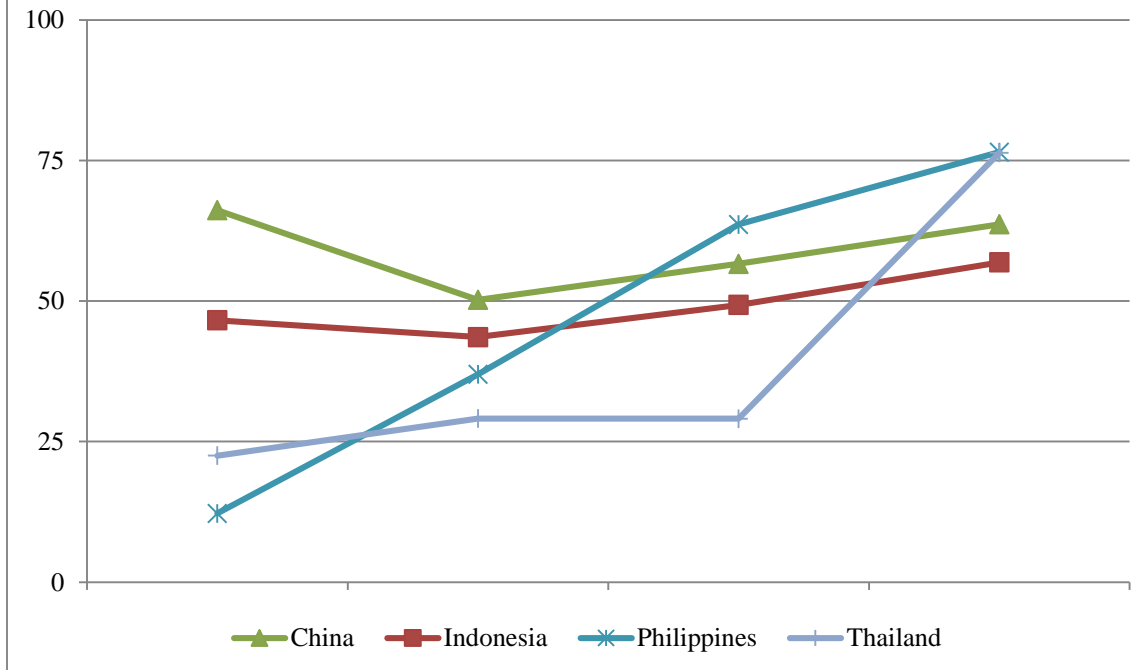

Figure Six: Percent Women Migrants to the UAE from Major Sending Countries, 1960-2000



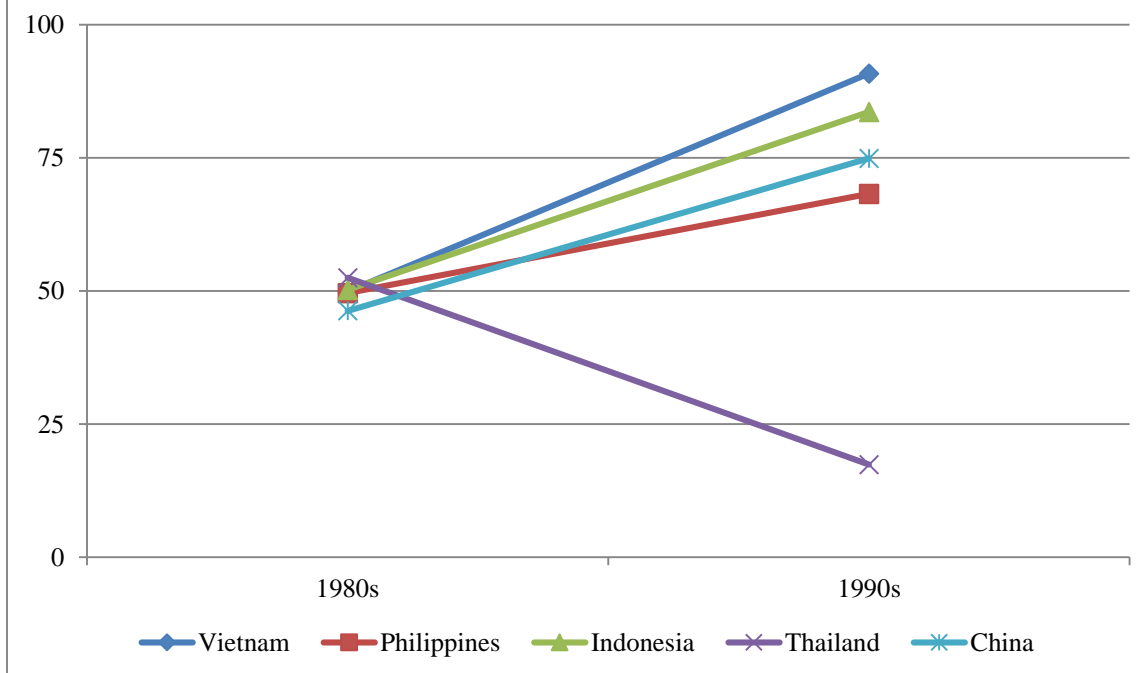

Figure Seven: Percent Women Migrants to Hong Kong from Major Sending Countries, 1960-2000

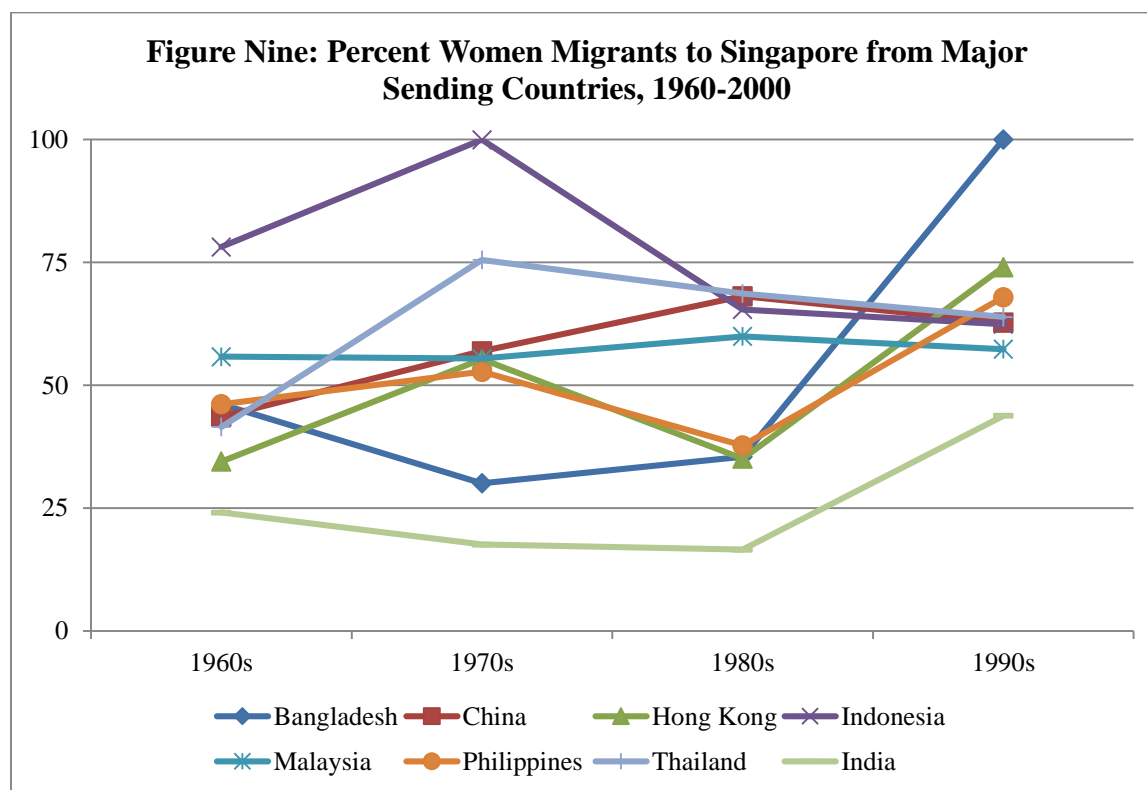

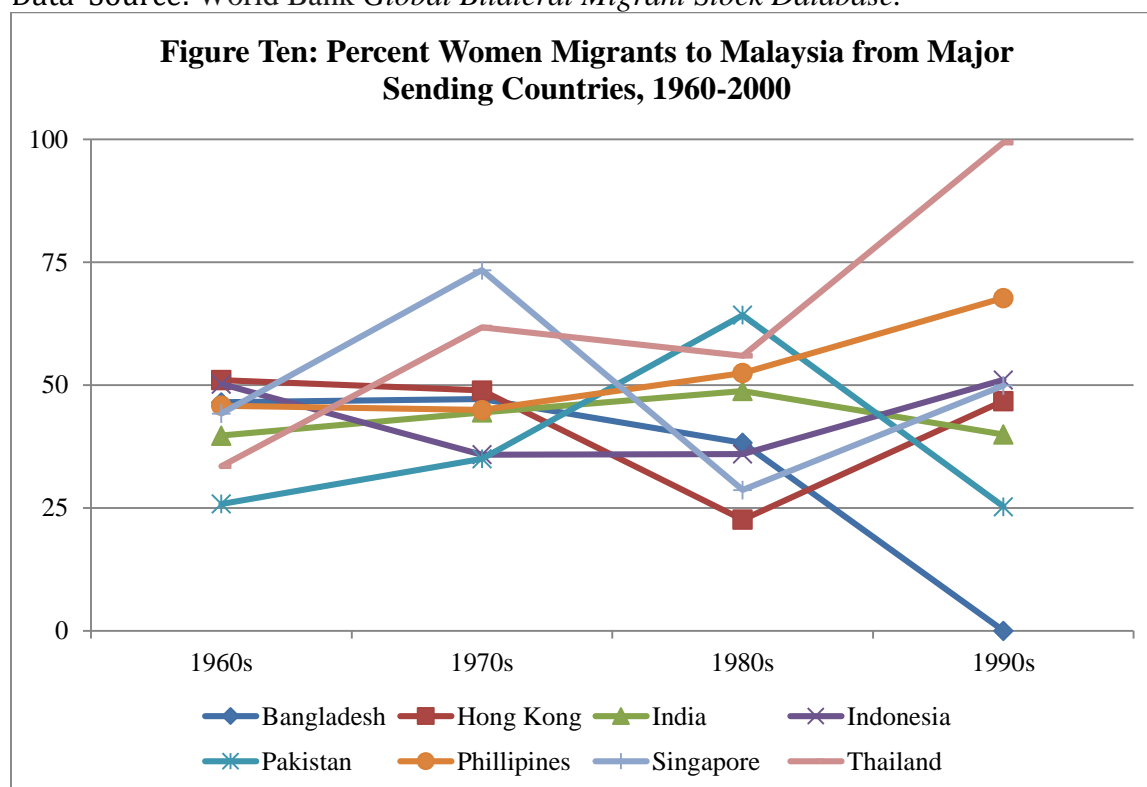
Figure Eight: Percent Women Migrants to Taiwan from Major Sending Countries, 1960-2000

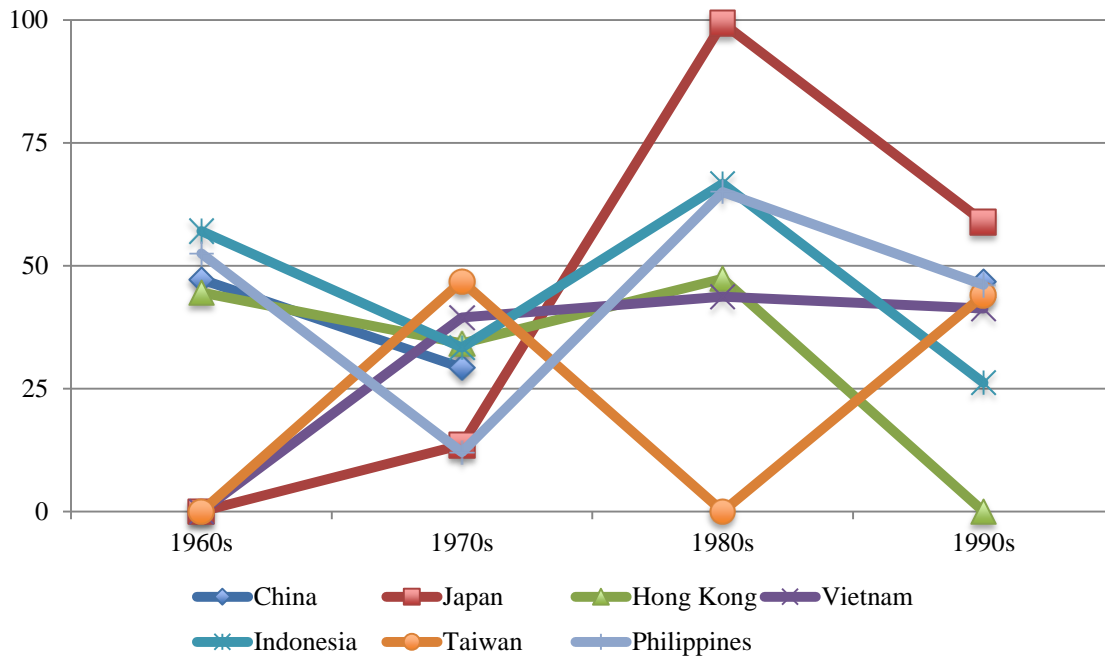

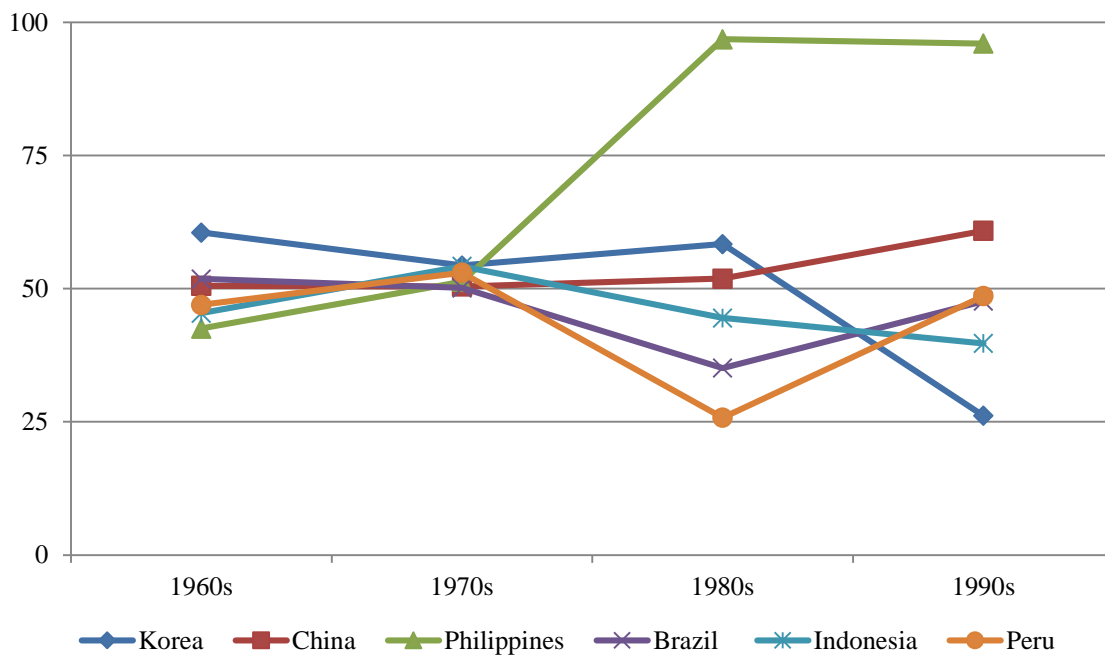
